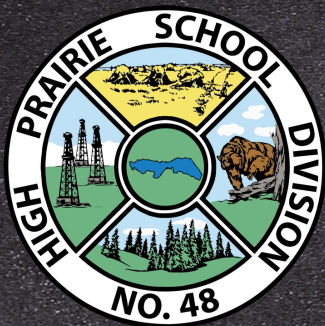

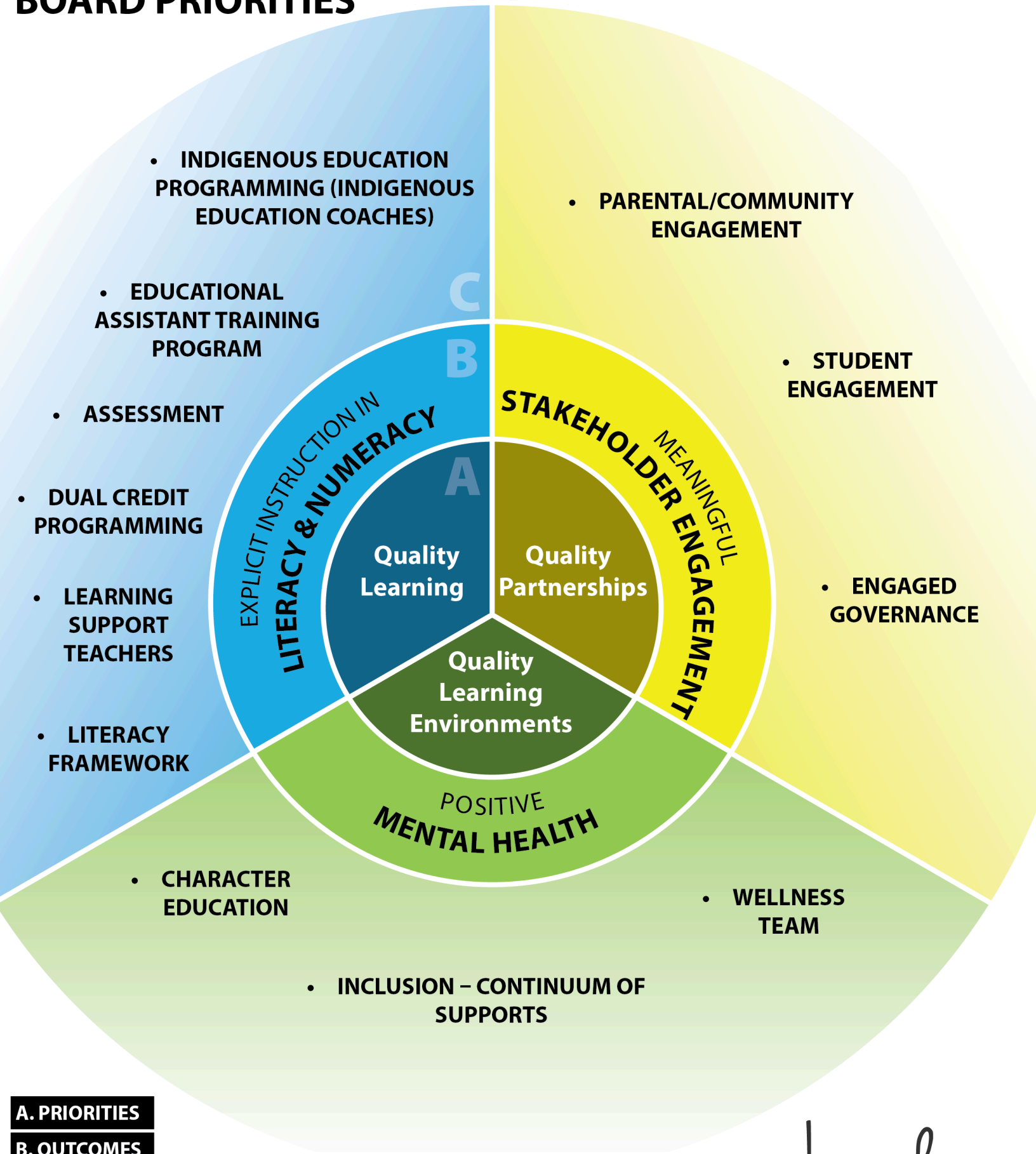

# Quality Learning

## Learning Support Teachers

The LST (Learning Support Teacher) works in close partnership with the administration team to ensure the school is an inclusive environment for all students. Kinuso School is lucky to have Mrs. Becki Cardinal working with us to ensure that our students are given the best learning opportunities possible! Here are just a few of the ways that Mrs. Cardinal supports our staff and students:

### Classroom Teachers:

- Work together to create a range of support options for students, based on their individual needs.
- Help design and track student progress in the classroom, making sure each child is getting the right level of support.
- Provide guidance on behavior strategies to help manage and support student behavior in a positive way.
- Ensure students' individual plans (IPPs) are being followed and adjusted as needed to help them succeed.
- Decide on the right interventions for reading and math to support each student's progress.
- Support the administration of assessments (like provincial or divisional tests), making sure all students are tested properly.
- Help make sense of test results and use them to adjust classroom teaching and support to better meet student needs.
- Model and share effective teaching strategies with other staff to ensure the best classroom practices.
- Support both in-class and outside-the-classroom help for students, whether they need extra support within the class or in a separate setting.

### Educational Assistants:

- Help make sure Educational Assistants (EAs) are used in the best way in the classroom to support students effectively.
- Organize and provide meaningful training for EAs so they have the skills needed to support students well.
- Talk about and track student behaviors and the best strategies to support each child's needs.
- Communicate daily with teachers and staff to make sure everyone is on the same page about student progress and needs.
- Work together to create and adjust student plans to make sure each child gets the right kind of support.
- Coach and collaborate with other staff to share strategies and ideas on how to best support students.

### Service Providers:

- Organize meetings and observations to bring in extra support from specialists, such as Speech/Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Deaf and Hard of Hearing Specialists, Psychologists, and Counselors.
- Share and put into action the advice and strategies from these specialists with Educational Assistants, classroom teachers, and administrators to ensure all staff are helping in the best way possible.
- Set up meetings with families and other professionals (like outside organizations or other experts) to make sure everyone involved is working together to support the student.
